

Mont de l'Arpille

As for Bovine, the Mont de l'Arpille is a top worth a hiking tour. In fact, the view that one enjoys there is magnificent. And, on the contrary to Bovine, one manages to see the Bietschhorn, a top located between the Rhone Valley and the Lötschental.

In addition, this mountain is made of moor land, providing a special look to the landscape.

One has to say that this mountain was about to be disfigured by constructions. In fact, after the war, a project was planning to build infrastructure for skiing. It is at the start of the building of the housing, that one realised that this top was lacking water. The project was abandoned, but not before having built a chair-lift starting from the Col de la Forclaz. One can still see its path in the woods.
