

Crossing from Sainte-Croix to Vallorbe

Usually, the term of crossing is understood, in the case of mountains, as the passage from one side to another of a mountain range, that is, in the transversal direction. In this case, it has to be understood as the crossing in the longitudinal sense. That is that we will follow the crest more or less on along the line of summits.

Starting from Sainte-Croix, we will however bypass the Aiguilles de Baulmes, because their ascension would significantly lengthen the hike. However, from Grange Neuve, we will follow a small concealed path that leads directly to the top of Suchet. The view from this top is absolutely beautiful.

Then, we will start the long descending crossing towards Vallorbe.

Depending on the level of tiredness, I might decide to take the train at le Day... the train station of Vallorbe is on the other side of the town and it is quite infuriating seeing the train passing by that one just missed...
