

## Crossing of Weissenstein

Amongst the beautiful crossings of Jura, the one of Weissenstein is certainly a bit particular. Especially, it requires a quite long travel with the train, which makes the experience a bit special. Starting from Gänsbrunnen (Saint Joseph) a pleasant path will have us climb the beautiful vale of Rüschraben. Leaving it, we will have a more and more wide view onto the surroundings. In addition, the view onto the Alps will be nice.

Once reached at Hinter Weissenstein, we might climb to the cave of Nidleloch (the hole of the cream). After a crossing of the pastures, we will reach Kurhaus Weissenstein where we will gaze at the remains of the former chair lift.

We will go down along the picturesque path of Stigelos. In order to reach Solothurn, we will cross the Verena Gorge, where a renowned hermitage is located.
